# SAN MARCOS HIGH SCHOOL SURF TEAM/CLUB



This document is to provide information about the San Marcos High School Surf Team/Club for the 2024-25 season.

**Participation**: While the team practices and events are open to all surfers regardless of grade level or surfing ability, only 19 surfers can surf in a Div. 3 contest. Contests include men's shortboard and longboard, women's shortboard and longboard, and

bodyboard. Only the best surfers will compete in contests, and a surfer will not be allowed to surf in more than five regular contests during a season.

All surfers who wish to participate in team or club beach events, including practices, must complete a SMHS surfing registration form, register with the Scholastic Surf Series, pay the team fee of \$200 (preferably by check payable to SMHS ABC or you can Venmo us), and raise an additional \$200 through our fundraiser. Scholastic Surf Series (SSS) membership must be done at <a href="https://app.surfsss.org/register">https://app.surfsss.org/register</a> by doing the following:

1. Select your team/school and complete the questionnaire. You will need your student's health insurance info.

## **Eligibility of Competitors**

- SSS is designed for a school-based surf team league.
- Members of a team must be enrolled full-time at the school for which they surf.
- Members enrolled full-time in Charter Schools or other California state-approved programs may surf for their school of residence (that which they would attend according to school district and home address) and must adhere to that school district's policy.
- If there is not a team at your school of residence, then you can choose another school in your school district.
- Students must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA to compete in SSS competitions.
- Shortboards 7'6" and under. Longboards 9 ft. or 3 ft. over the surfer's head.
- All required forms and membership fees are received by SSS.

**Season**: The SSS surf season consists of five contests for each division, and the State Championships. The season begins in October and ends with the State Championships in April (assuming we qualify). Visit the SSS website for more information at surfsss.org. ## **Judging Criteria**

Surfers must perform to the WSL judging key elements to maximize their scoring potential. Judges analyze the following major elements when scoring waves.

#### Shortboard and Bodyboard

- Commitment and degree of difficulty in critical section of the wave.
- Innovative and progressive maneuvers.
- Combination of major maneuvers.
- Variety of maneuvers.
- Speed, power, and flow.

## Longboard

The surfer must perform controlled maneuvers in the critical section of the wave utilizing the entire board and wave using traditional longboard surfing. The surfer who performs this to the highest degree of difficulty with the most style, flow and grace will receive the highest score for a ride. Further, the following are key elements for judges to consider:

- Nose riding and rail surfing
- Critical section of the wave
- Variety of maneuvers
- Speed and Power/Commitment
- Control / Footwork

**Practice:** The team will practice afterschool on Thursdays at Grandview Beach at 3:30 p.m., Saturdays at 8:30 a.m. at Ponto Beach, and occasional early morning practice on Tuesdays due to late start at the school. *Please note*: Based on surf conditions, the coaching staff may make changes to the practice locations at any time. Keep your phone with you to be notified of location changes.

**Contests:** Surfers who wish to compete in contests MUST attend and participate in practices. Failure to attend and participate in practice will result in forfeiting the ability to compete in contests.

#### **Code of Conduct**

- Surfers are representing San Marcos High School and San Marcos Unified School
  District at all team activities (practices, competitions, fund-raisers, etc.). Students
  must adhere to the policies of San Marcos High School and the San Marcos Unified
  School District, and shall conduct themselves in a manner that will bring credit and
  respect to San Marcos High School and the team.
- The use of alcohol, tobacco or drugs at any time while representing San Marcos High School Surf Team may result in dismissal from the team. This includes practice, competitions, fundraising activities and any club-sponsored event.
- Teamwork, cooperation, and dedication are essential to the success of the team. This requires all team members to show respect to each the coaches, and other adults, and to each other. Disrespect to the coaches, adults, and team members will not be tolerated. Continued disrespect may result in suspension and or dismissal from the team.
- Surfers are expected to participate in any fundraising and community service activities.
- Surfers, parents, and coaches are required to abide by the SSS's Unsportsmanlike Conduct rule which states "Any display of poor sportsmanship by either a competitor, coach, or parent, shall be cause for automatic dismissal from the contest."
- Surfers, parents, and family members must remove all their own trash from the beach after practices and contests.
- Surfers are expected to follow the rules of surf etiquette when in the water and respect local surfers. Failure to follow surf etiquette may result in being asked to leave the water for the rest of a practice or contest.
